On September 20th, our students will be participating in the Terry Fox run in order to raise money for Cancer. Our run will take place at 11:30 am (weather permitting). Students are asked to bring in "Toonies for Terry" which will be donated. Pledge forms were sent home earlier this month. If students have collected pledges from family members and friends, that is appreciated. All pledge forms (with pledges or not) and money are due back at school Friday, September 21st.

In order to reach our goal of 2,500.00, I have committed to do the following:

- \$ 500.00 - I will wear funny a costume for one day and visit each classroom
- \$ 1000.00 - I will allow the class who has raised the most money to throw a whip cream pie in my face in front of the whole school
- \$1500.00 - I will do the 'water bucket challenge'
